Student Learning Outcomes for the B.A. in French

The French major is a designated capstone major. Students are required to complete a capstone seminar that is thematically devised to reflect current trends in the discipline. Graduates will be able to:

- demonstrate a mastery of the French language, both written and oral.
- demonstrate, within the context of a specialized topic in French and Francophone studies, specific skills and expertise acquired in earlier coursework, including research, analysis and writing.
- identify and analyze appropriate primary sources.
- acquire a working knowledge of scholarly discourse relative to a specialized topic.
- conceive and execute a project that identifies and engages with a specialized topic.
- engage with a community of scholars, presenting one's own work to peers and helping to further the work of those peers through discussion and critique
